**ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF DEAD WILDLIFE**

WHEREAS, Comal County has an interest in protecting the health and safety of its citizens in its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Comal County desires to remove dead wildlife from private real property solely within the unincorporated areas of Comal County; and

WHEREAS, upon the request of the resident, Comal County may elect to remove said dead wildlife; and


WHEREAS, wildlife is hereby defined as any mammal living in a natural and undomesticated state; and


WHEREAS, the Comal County Engineer has the resources, and equipment to provide this service;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that Commissioners Court of Comal County authorizes the Comal County Engineer to review resident requests for dead wildlife removal and, if deemed appropriate, to remove said dead wildlife after obtaining a signed permit by the resident to enter the resident's property.
