The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed its review of the request for technical clarification of the approved CZP for the above-referenced project submitted to the San Antonio Regional Office by Comal County on December 10, 2010. Final review of the request was completed after additional material was received on April 5, April 11, and April 12, 2011.

As presented to the TCEQ, the submitted request describes a proposed change to the layout of the three baseball fields located at the west side of the site. The request states the previously approved finished contours will remain the same and there will be no change to the 50 foot vegetated filter strip located along the north side of the site. The request includes the assurance that there will be no increase in impervious cover and that the integrated pest management plan in the previously approved CZP will still be applied.

Based on the engineer's concurrence of compliance, and the submitted planning materials, the proposed project does not include any activities outlined in 30 TAC 213.23(i) that would require a modification to the approved CZP. The above referenced file will be updated with the submitted information. Please note the activities described in the submitted request are subject to the approved CZP and

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all Special and Standard Conditions listed in the CZP approval letter dated November 12, 2009.
