RE: The Summit Subdivision, Comal County. Edwards Aquifer Rule 156.20.05.008

This is in response to your request for approval of a water pollution abatement plan for the above-referenced subdivision in Comal County. The plan has been reviewed pursuant to Texas Water Development Board Rule 156.20.05.008 which specifies water pollution abatement activities for subdivisions located on the Recharge Zone of the Edwards Aquifer.


As outlined in the application, this subdivision will consist of 185 single-family residential lots on approximately 230 acres. Sewage disposal will be by means of private sewage facilities.

The construction standards and pollution abatement activities proposed by the applicant are in general agreement with Rule No. 156.20.05.008 and the subdivision plan is approved with the following provisions:

1. The caves and boring identified in the geologic report accompanying the application shall be properly sealed to prevent rapid infiltration of surface runoff.
2. Septic tanks and drain fields shall be located down-gradient from these openings.

The developer shall comply with all applicable provisions of Texas Water Development Board Rule 156.20.05 and shall be responsible for compliance with such provisions until such responsibility is legally transferred to another person or entity.
