Soil is to be replaced with the excavated material as best as possible.

Termination of Agreement

Either party may terminate this agreement within ten days of start date by providing written notice if the other party substantially fails to perform in accordance with the terms of the agreement, without fault of terminating party. If this Agreement is terminated, the Contractor will immediately notify the appropriate health authority. Customers will receive a pro rata refund for the balance of their contract if canceled after the initial 10 day period.

Limit of Liability

In no event shall the Contractor be liable for indirect, consequential, incidental or punitive damages, whether in contract tort or any other theory. In no event shall the Contractor's liability for direct damages exceed the price for the services described in this Agreement.

Dispute Resolution

If a dispute between the Client and the Contractor arises that cannot be settled in good faith negotiations then the parties shall choose a mutually acceptable arbitrator and shall share the cost of the arbitration services equally.

Entire Agreement

This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties, and there are no other promises or conditions in any other agreement either oral or written.
